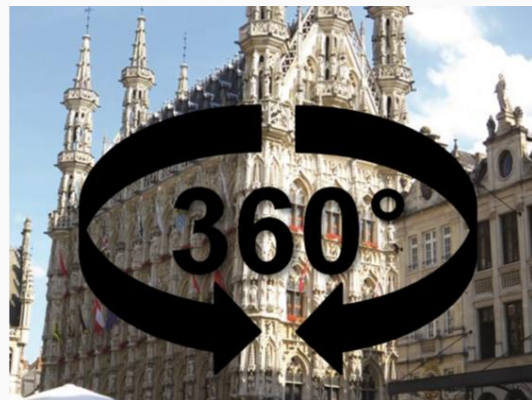


Take the virtual tour
